
What started as a fun idea to get our families together has grown into an annual tradition.












The EDPA Las Vegas chapter has become well known with regular attendees for both quality and quantity of raffle prizes at our events year round. Susan Medica of AFR heads up our Raffle Prize committee and does a phenomenal job of beautiful presentation at the events. She and her team solicit donations from local businesses to create packages for our Opportunity Ticket prizes at our annual golf tournament with some exceeding \$2,000 value.
